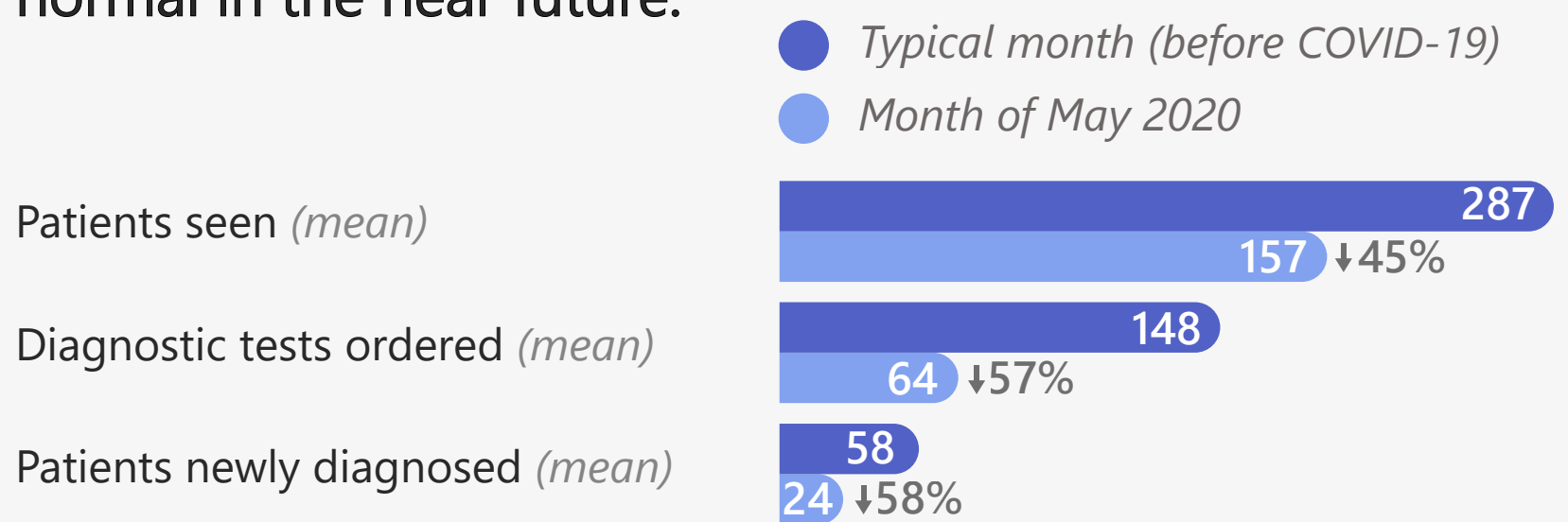


Will the Changes Caused by COVID-19 Become Physicians' New Normal?



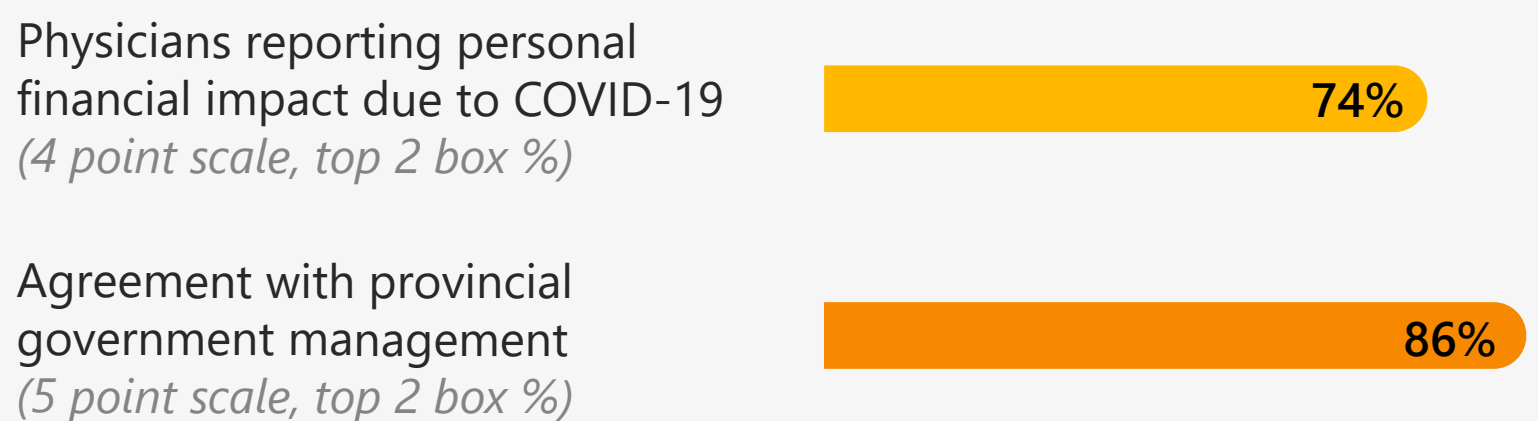
COVID-19 has significantly impacted physician workloads and physicians **don't foresee** things getting back to normal in the near future.



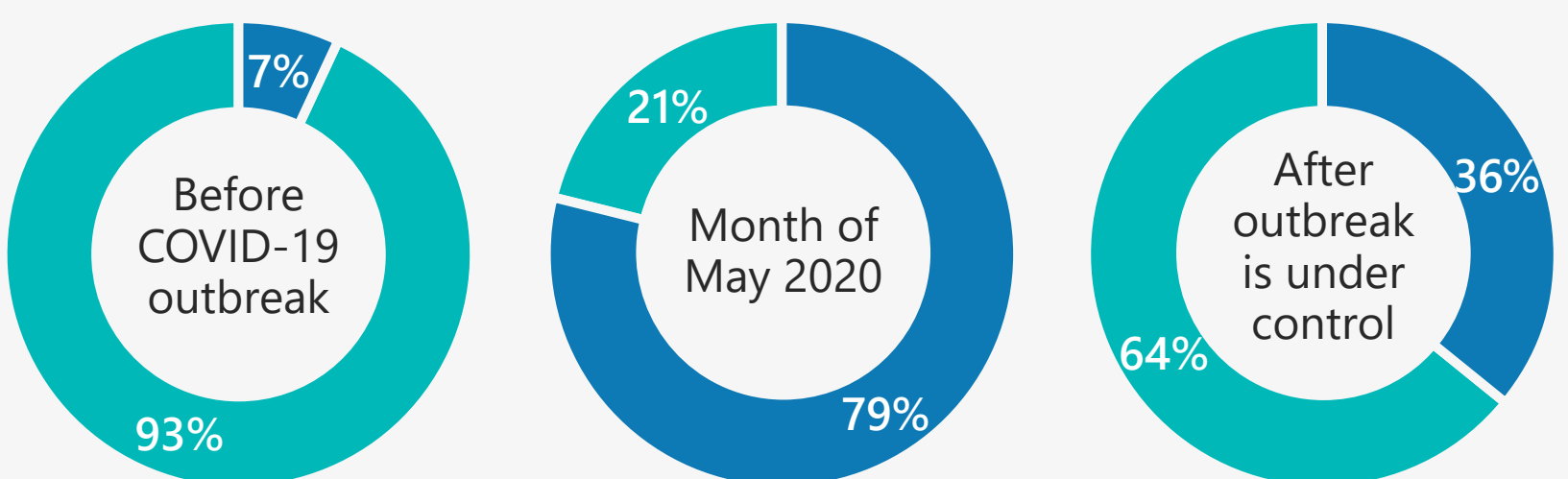
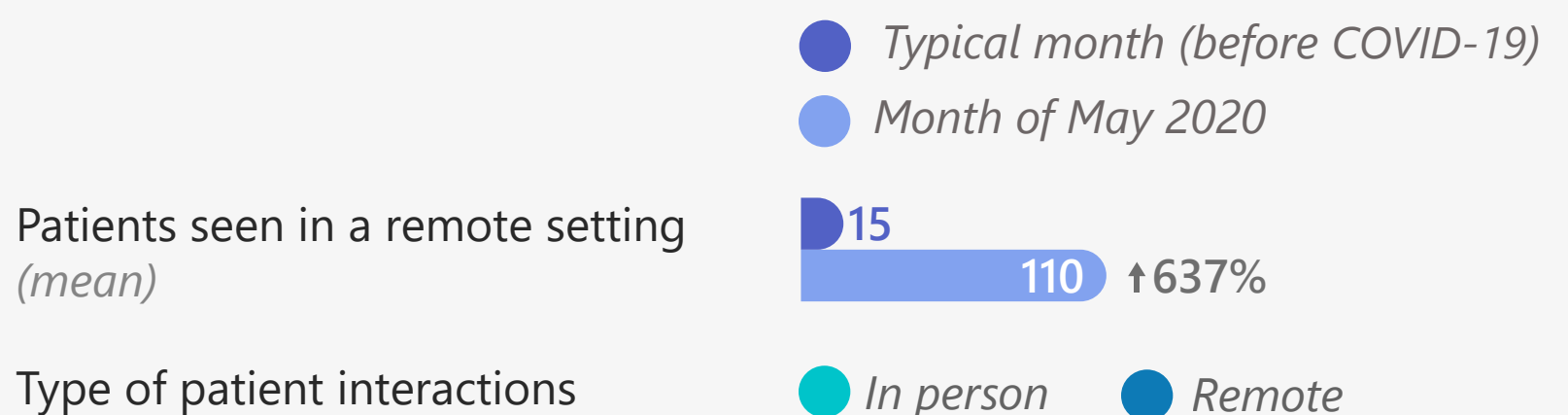
While COVID-19 has caused a reduction in workload, 45% of physicians anticipate becoming busier in the coming weeks/months.



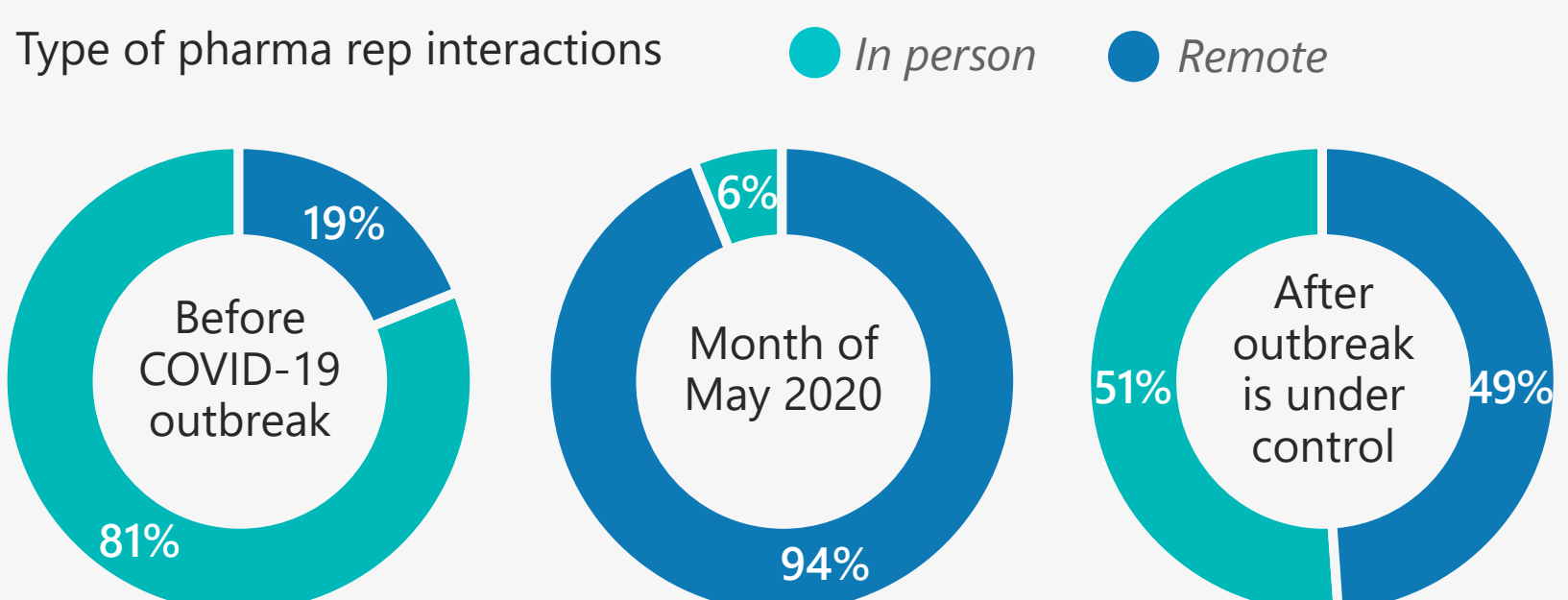
Despite being financially impacted by COVID-19, physicians agree with how their provincial government has managed the crisis.

Similarly, physicians expect pharma rep interactions to **keep more of a remote component** even after COVID-19 is under control.
