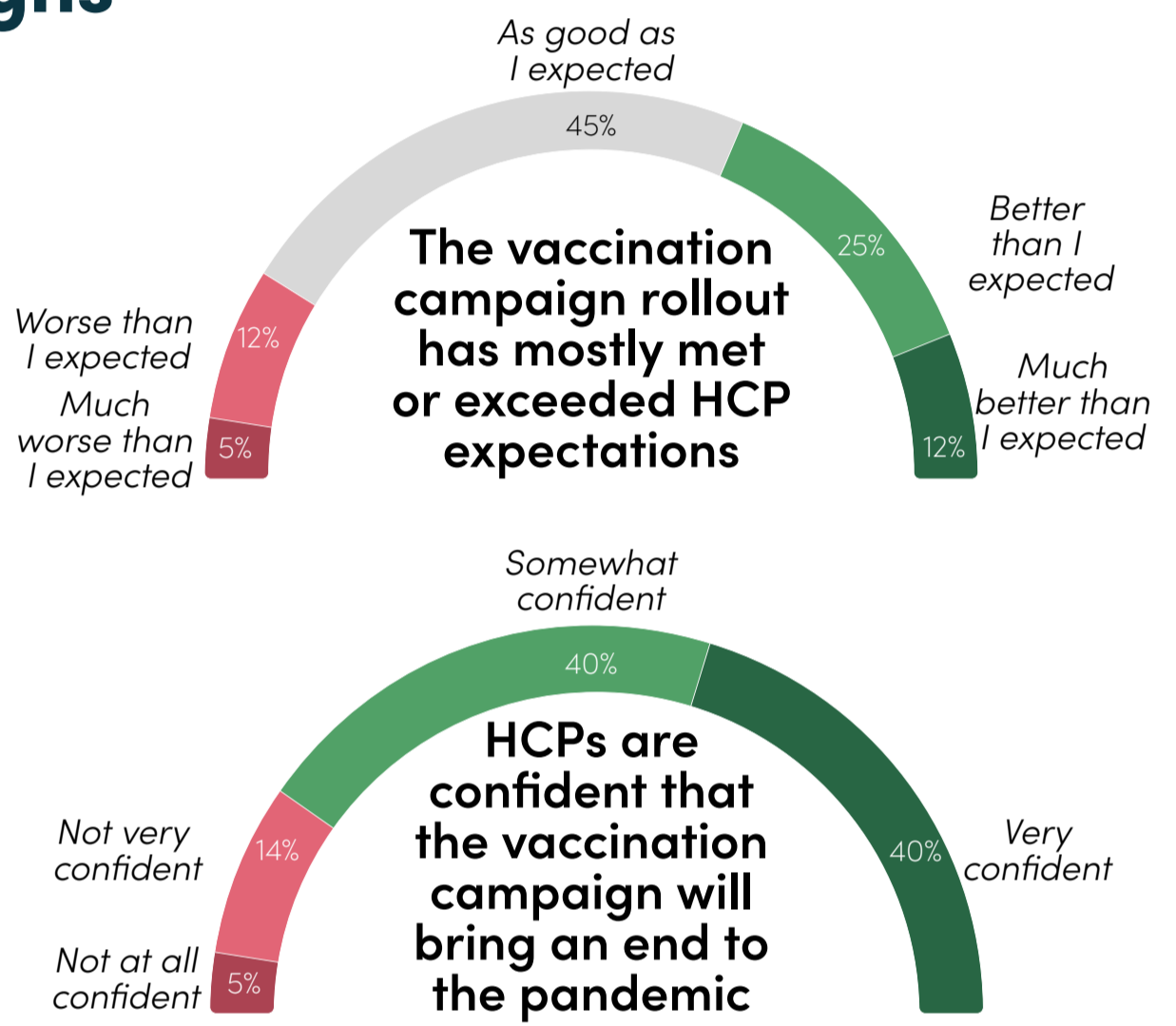
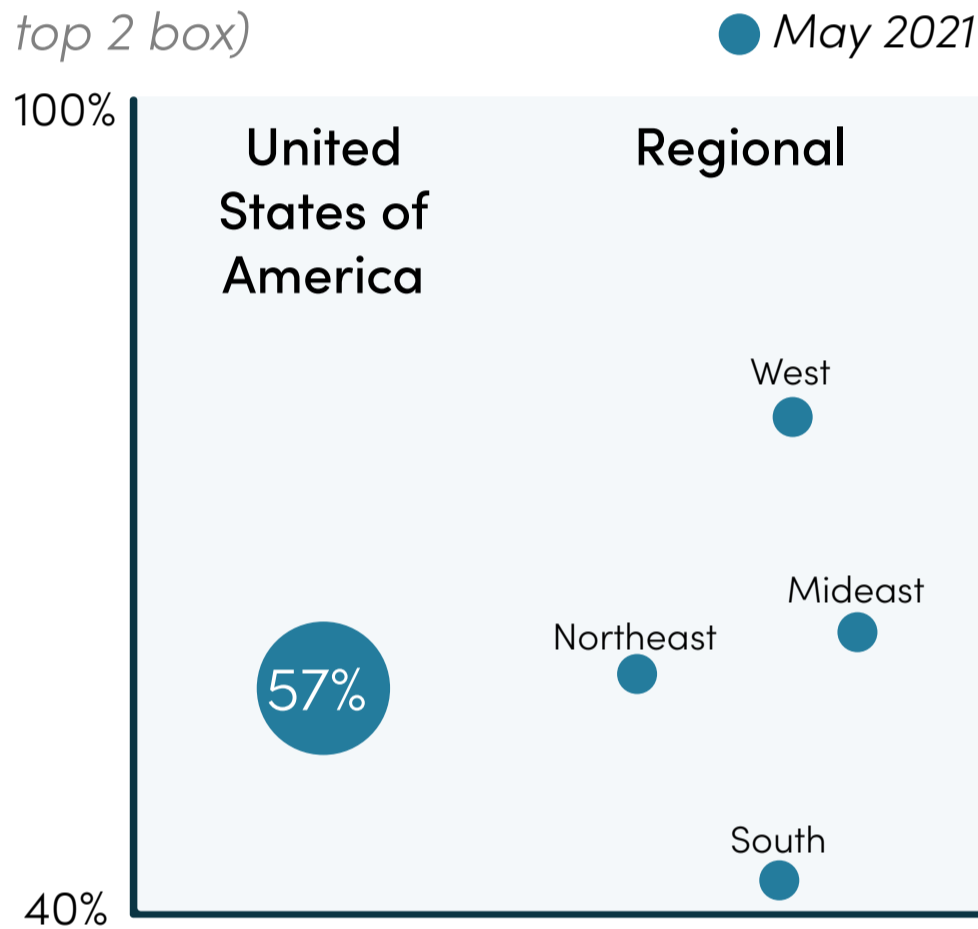

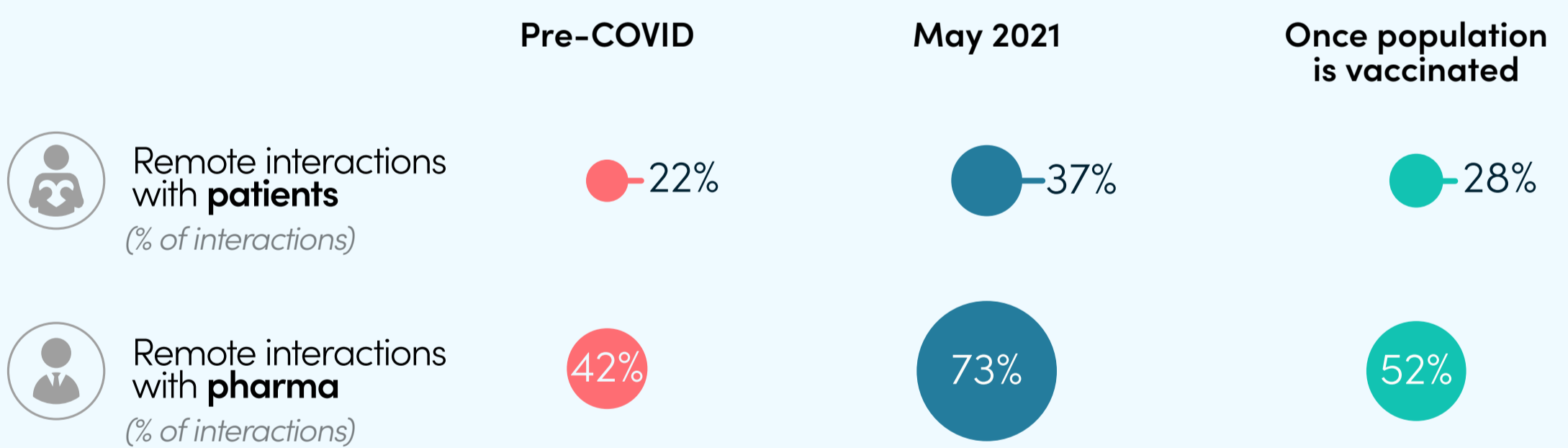
HCPs Are Split on Perceptions of State Vaccine Campaigns

Agreement with State's Vaccination Campaign

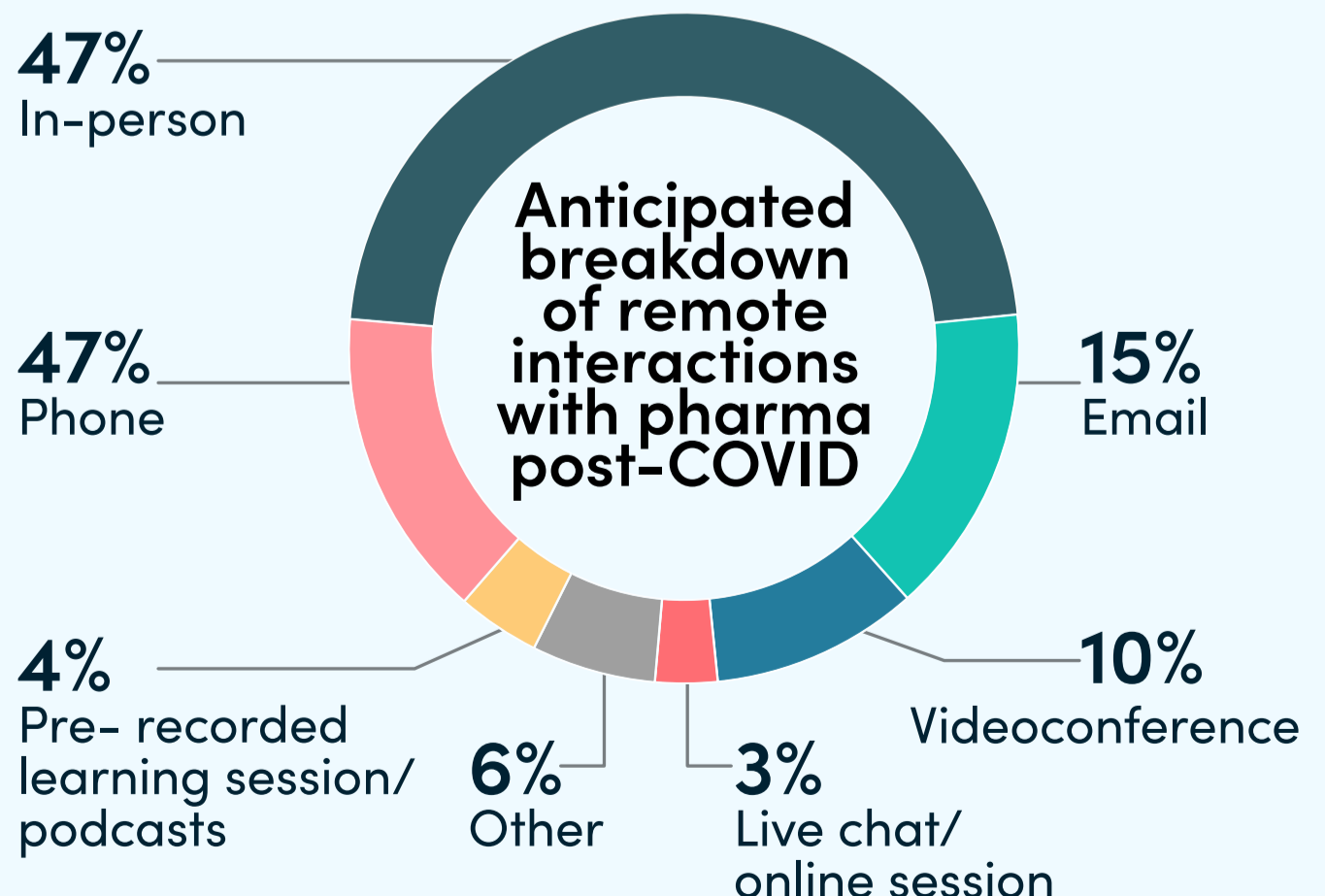
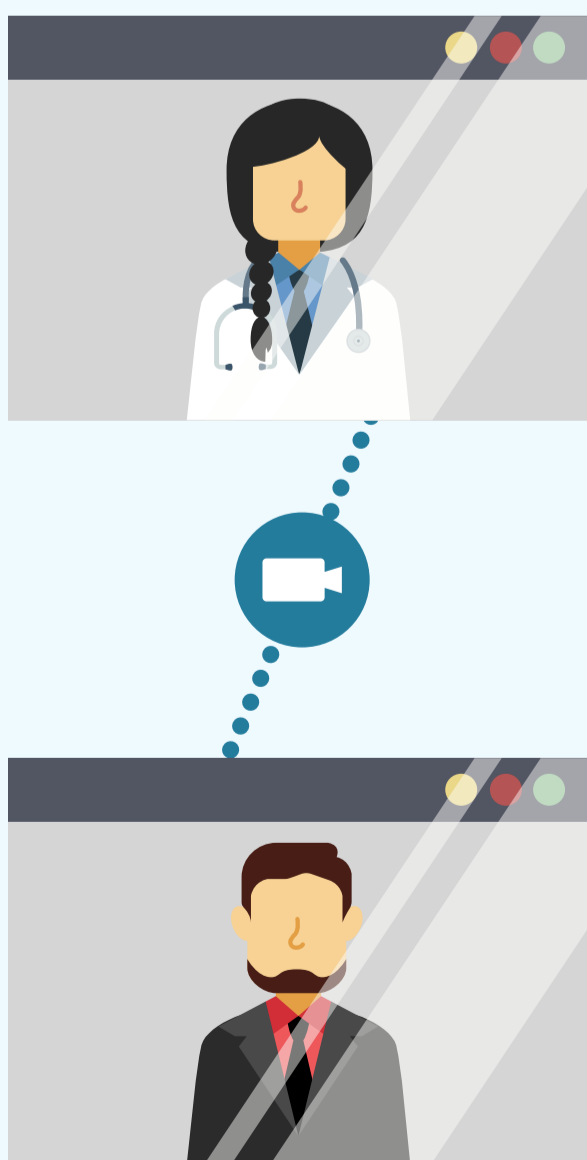
(5-point agreement scale, top 2 box)
