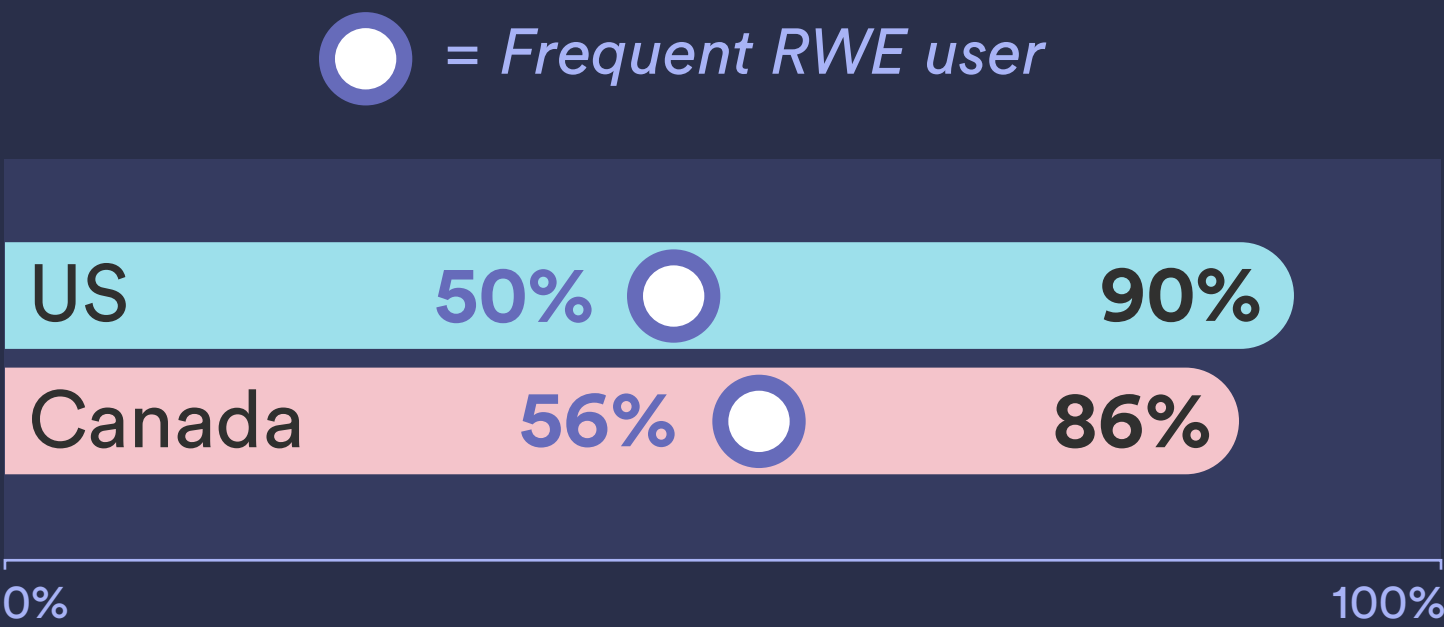


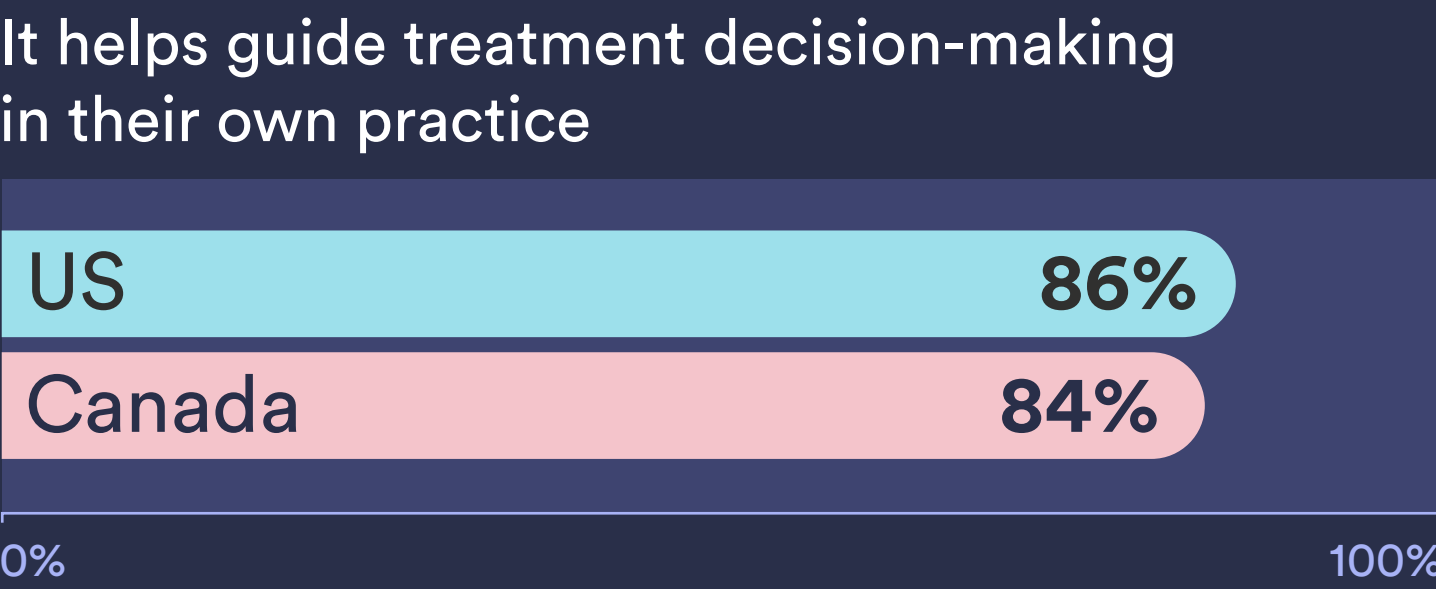
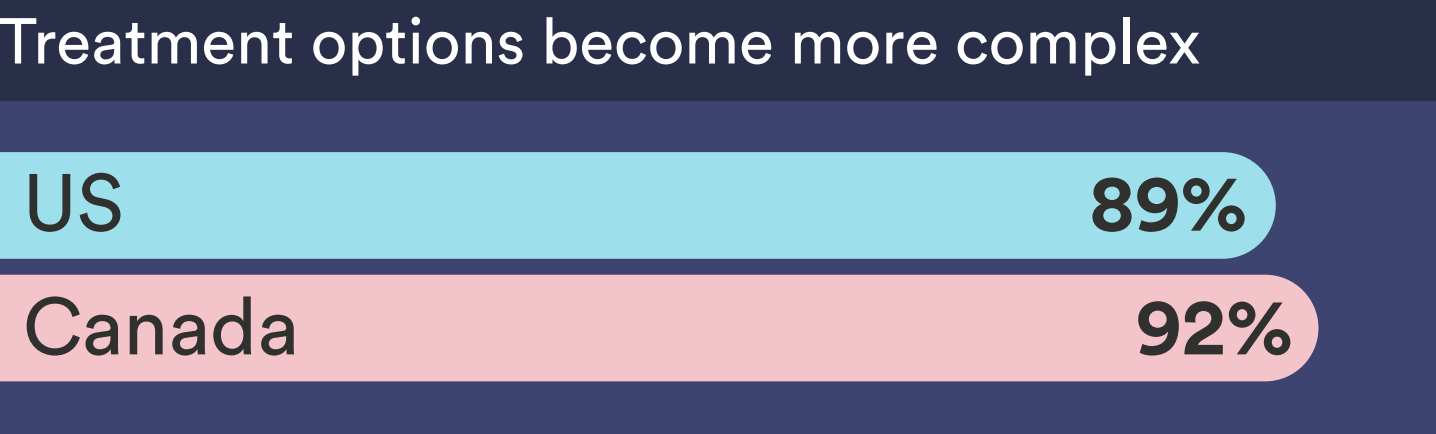
Use of Real-World Evidence in Oncology



The majority of oncologists say they at least occasionally rely on real-world evidence (RWE) to inform their current practice. Among those, approximately half say they rely on RWE often or almost always.
